Chill out day

Our second of the school councilor charity days is fast approaching. 'Chill Out day' (this is the

Could children all contribute £2 (on ParentPay) to cover refreshments and their donation to Dog's Trust, who will be coming in to do an assembly (but not bringing a dog, so please reassure anyone who is nervous).

Reports

Your child's report will be sent out to you on Friday 12th July. This will include their current attainment levels and the results of any statutory tests they have taken. We will include explanations of the levels on the reverse of the parent response slips (in an attempt to reduce paper waste). You may note that the official KS2 (Y6) SATs test results are due to be released on 9th July. However, we don't mention this at all to the children for several reasons. The first is that the online portal for accessing the results is overwhelmed every year and is unable to cope with demand, so we never know what time of the day we will be able to download them. We then make time to download the test papers of children who are on the borderline of age-related or high score results and check that we are happy with the marking – if we are not satisfied, we will let you know that we are getting a test re-marked. The other reason is that we don't want our children to focus too heavily on the number they received. We know that our children have worked so hard, and we don't want them to judge their achievement from a result that doesn't tell them what sort of learner they have become, or how much progress they have made. We put the result in with their report so that on the Friday night, you can talk to them about what they achieved, tell them they're wonderful and then get on with your weekend. We appreciate your support in this.
