Safer Internet Day

Attendance

We have just sent home our second round of fortnightly attendance letters to let you know if your child has dipped below 95% or into the 'persistent absentee' realms of 90% or below. Please come and see us if we can be of any help with attendance. We understand that it is very difficult to meet attendance expectations with so many bugs and viruses around at the moment. Please rest assured, these letters are not intended as a criticism, and remember that each percentage is taken from September, so if your child has been poorly during the autumn term, it may take quite a few weeks for their percentage to move back into the 'above 95%' category. We will still send you the letters to help you keep track of their percentage. You may have noticed that the government have launched a campaign to improve school attendance and our policy complies with some of the actions that they have asked of us. However, we will not be going back to attendance awards, as attendance is not a Parochial value – we celebrate kindness, service, resilience and friendship. Children cannot help being ill!
