29/9/25	Black History Month – link to Justice	Recycle week – stewardship of our planet (25 th – 1 st)	In collective worship this week we have thought about the jobs that God has given us – to look after the planet and his people. We talked about the importance of recycling and made promises to look after our world.	Discuss and make some pledges / promises around recycling and taking care of our world. (Y4*)
6/10/25	Hello Yellow (10 th) (Positive mental health)	"Love one another" (R&F2)	In our collective worship we have thought about how to live our best, and happiest life, and how to support others to do the same.	Could we write an encouraging letter or postcard for someone who is anxious or sad? What would it say? (Y3*)

13/10/25	The Lord's Prayer "This is how you should pray" (R&F2)	Worship led by Andy Gawn – "We are made different from animals"	In our collective worship we have thought about how we treat the animals on our planet.	Create an animal rights charter – what rules should we follow in the way we treat our animal neighbours? (Y2*)
20/10/25	Harvest	Food banks (link to service)	In our collective worship this week we have thought about the blessings we have been given and thought about ways for us to say 'Thank you'.	Prayers of thanks for Harvest – can all pupils from Y2 upward do this and we will display some at Harvest. I'll create some templates.

Thanksgiving	In our collective worship this week we have thought about the American holiday of thanksgiving, and said prayers of thanks for all the blessings in our lives.	This will be delivered on Thanksgiving Day, so think about all the think about what they are grateful for and make their own prayer of thanksgiving. (Y3*)
1/12/25	Advent	The Good Samaritan - who is my neighbour?	In our collective worship this week we have thought about who our neighbour is. We have talked about the story of the Good Samaritan.	Think about who is our neighbour. Show a picture of Thiago – how is he the same as us? What do his mum and dad want for him? Is he our neighbour? (Y6*)
8/12/25	Worship led by Andy Gawn – "Christmas!"	"Jesus is Born" (R&F2)	In our collective worship we have been thinking about the true meaning of Christmas and thanking God for the gift of Jesus.	Create a prayer to thank God for the gift of Jesus. (Y1*)
15/12/25	Christmas Jumper Day	Christmas around the World	In collective worship this week we have looked at Christmas around the world, and noticed that light is a theme in many traditions! We thought about what this tells us about Jesus and how it links to our school motto.
